Bring a lace the pillow of your choice and usual bobbin lacemaking supplies such as: a pricker, pattern film, a light if you need one, etc.

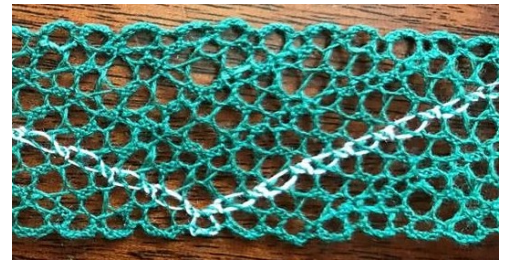
The patterns are designed for 80/3 linen (Goldshild), but can be altered as desired.

Michele is local to our area and hosts a social "bring in what you are working on" event each Thursday at the museum from 11am-1pm every week.

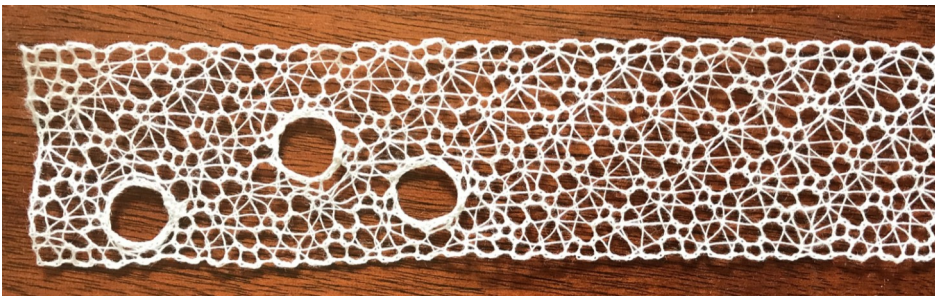


Class Fee: \$150
