## Class Description

This class is designed to teach the basics of needle lace and how it relates to all things zen.

At home the student will be instructed to finish a partially basted outline ( Zen – string). The class time will then be used to learn the filing stitches (Zen – doodles or tangles) and work them to fill the spaces. It is an easy art to carry with you and relaxing to do. Students will finish a motif that will fit in a coaster blank that will be available for purchase at the museum.

## Needle Lace Kit - \$10

Cloth working pad with pattern basted on and covered with plastic

Needles - 1 sharp for basting  
- 1 tapestry #26 for making the lace

Thread - DMC Fil A Dentelle 80, color 3688

### **Payable to the museum – includes postage**

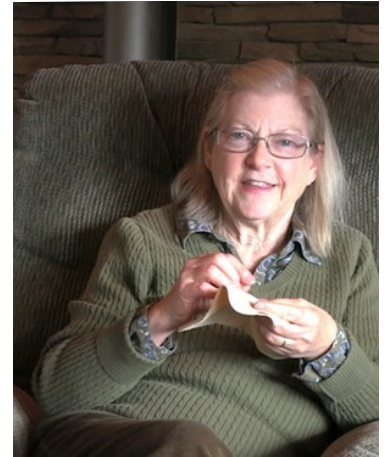
Optional coaster blank – purchased from the museum
