This class will cover the elegant hand sewing techniques used to join entredeux, beading, insertion and lace edgings to create a heart or ball ornament or sachet. French seams, pin-tucks and roll and whip technique will be included.

Sewing Kit

A kit with all needed supplies will be available for purchase at the museum. Please bring your own thread scissors.
