In this class, learn how to work needlelace petals in 17th century techniques. The addition of a more contemporary method of wired edge petals will also be taught. Techniques include needlelace and wired 3-D petals. This class will take place at the Sunnyvale Lace Museum.

Lucy Barter is from Suffolk, England, she is the Co-Founder of the San Francisco School of Needlework and Design and the sole proprietor of Forever Embroidery Studio. Lucy knew early on that she had a passion



for textile-related work, and sought a degree in Fashion Design at the University of Northumbria, where she received her BA Honors Degree.

Lucy sought to further her studies and passion for needlework by enrolling into the Royal School of Needlework's Apprenticeship, where she graduated with Distinction in 2006. From 2007 – 2015, Lucy acted as ambassador and instructor for the RSN in the United States.

In 2015, Lucy cofounded the non-profit school, San Francisco School of Needlework and Design with the expectation of forming a world-class center for hand-embroidery. She has lectured at many San Francisco

Bay Area embroidery guilds, at the Metropolitan Club, and at the De Young Museum in San Francisco.

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
