Chrysanthemum lace is a wonderful free lace that can be a stepping stone for beginners looking to venture beyond continuous laces. For the advanced students it can be a resting project for the sake of creating something unusual and beautiful. Students will learn the basics of Chrysanthemum lace-making; including the pivot pin and the split spider stitch. There will be a choice of patterns from Sylvia's original designs.
