Needle Lace has been made for centuries using thread so fine you need magnification to examine it. That is not an easy way to understand the basics. In this beginning Needle Lace workshop, you will learn two fundamental stitches with a size 5 perle cotton so you can easily see where your needle needs to go. The two stitches taught in this project are Single Corded Brussels and Double Corded Brussels. Once mastered, the stitch techniques can be applied to other fiber work.

*Class Fee: \$50 kit included*

- Bring thread scissors, light and magnification if needed.
