Course Description

Melanie will be using this design to teach adaption of vintage patterns using both shuttle and needle techniques along with discussing uses of tatting. The design is based on Sonata in g minor BWV 1034 by Johann Sebastian Bach. She will be discussing color and the addition of beads to a pattern.

Beginners ARE WELCOME! Students who are able to complete rings, chains and joins are comfortable adding beads and are ready to learn about basic designing principles will be able to best grasp concepts being taught. e student will need 2 shuttles and/or needles with 3 balls of differently colored thread in the size they are most comfortable. Bead are optional.



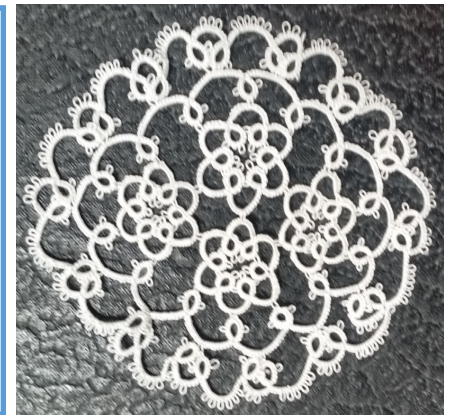
Melanie Cervi
