

Idrija Narrow Tape 3-Dimensional Angel

MATERIALS THAT YOU NEED FOR CLASS ARE:

PILLOW:

- a 20-inch cookie pillow **or**
- a traditional bolster pillow

BOBBINS:

- (for cookie pillow) 5 pairs of Dutch, Belgium Std or similar continental bobbins wound in pairs with approximately 1 ½ yards per bobbin. Wind your bobbins in the direction you normally would.
- (for bolster pillow) 5 pairs of large continental bobbins such as Idrija, Slovak, Spanish, or German Hooded. If you are winding bobbins for use on a bolster pillow, please contact me by email if you are unsure how to wind them.

THREAD:

- #30 Idrija cotton, Idrija metallic or Cantu cotton thread

PINS:

- (for cookie pillow) 26 x.65 pins or pins you would use for Torchon lace
- (for bolster pillow) Idrija lace pins (available from Designs by Marguccio) or 30 x.60 [1 1/8 inch].

PATTERN: Your pattern will be printed on light weight card stock. Please cover it with clear contact as the ink may rub off on your thread. If you are going to be pinning your pattern to a bolster pillow, do not cut it in a circle. Rectangular or square pieces are easier to pin to a bolster. **DO NOT PRICK YOUR PATTERN.**

OTHER:

- .6 crochet hook
- A cover cloth or a cloth with a hole cut in center (You will be turning your work a lot and a cloth helps to prevent threads from snagging on pins.)
- Pen/pencil (FOR NOTES)
- Contact paper
- Table and light
