

Point Ground Clothwork

Tools & Materials

- Pencil
- Eraser
- Fineliner pen
- Whiteout fluid
- Scissors
- Paper glue stick
- A sheet of tracing paper/translucent paper (if you don't have a lightbox or a bright window) - make sure you can see a pen line clearly through the paper, and that you can draw on it easily with a pencil.
- Isometric graph paper printouts:
 - 3mm Isometric graph paper in letter size (You will need 5 copies at least)
 - 5mm isometric graph paper in letter size (You will need 5 copies at least)

For the final design you will need either of the following two sets of materials according to your preference:

OPTION 1: Wet media:

Water-based ink or watercolour (tube or tile)

A sheet of white/light coloured paper

A broad flat brush (between 1.5cm and 3cm wide)

Paper towel for blotting and cleaning

OPTION 2: Dry Media:

A sheet of newspaper or any thin soft paper (an old telephone directory e.g)

A sheet of paper in a contrasting colour to the newspaper (coloured craft paper will do - it need not contrast radically - just different enough to be visibly different and to be able to see the edges of the newspaper clearly if you lay it over the paper
