

Students will be able to explore a new project or continue with a piece-in-progress. A variety of patterns are available, providing plenty of options for all levels.

SUPPLIES: Prickings and a supply list will be mailed to you. Louise offers a broad range of designs to suit Milanese students at the beginning, intermediate, and advanced levels. *A solid foundation in bobbin lace skills is required for this class.*
