

Supply List for
Milanese Cherries

Bobbins:

You may use whichever bobbins you prefer; I use Midlands bobbins with small spangles as my personal preference.

Threads:

This piece is worked in Mez (formerly Coats) cotton 50 in two shades. It is approximately 36wpc.
14 prs in Mez shade 7715 for each cherry.

8 prs in Mez shade 6527 for stem and stalks + a further 13 prs for the leaf.

You will also need the usual lacemaking equipment; I recommend the following items.

Round (cookie) pillow, minimum size 18" diameter, but also avoid a pillow that is too large. You turn the pillow quite a bit when working this type of lace.

Pins. I recommend a 26mm x 0.5 or 0.53 pin.

A 0.4mm crochet hook. You may use a lazy Susan (lazy maid) if you prefer.

I recommend a circular cover cloth with a central hole if you have one.
