

## Supply List for Intermediate Milanese Snowdrop

### Bobbins:

Students will need 28 pairs of bobbins wound with either Finca 60, Finca 80 or Finca 100 thread or suitable alternative. For guidance, Finca 60 is 38 wpc, Finca 80 is 43 wpc, and Finca 100 is 54 wpc. You may use whichever bobbins you prefer; I use Midlands bobbins with small spangles as my personal preference.

You will also need the usual lacemaking equipment; I recommend the following items.

Round (cookie) pillow, minimum size 18" diameter, but also avoid a pillow that is too large. You turn the pillow quite a bit when working this type of lace.

Pins. For size 60 thread I recommend a 26mm x 0.5 or 0.53 pin. For size 80 and 100 a 26mm x 0.4mm pin is appropriate.

A 0.4mm crochet hook. You may use a lazy Susan (lazy maid) if you prefer.

I recommend a circular cover cloth with a central hole if you have one.

For the first session you will need to prepare 28 pairs of bobbins in your chosen thread as we will be starting 2 sections of the design in this session. I recommend winding one bobbin of each pair more fully, then winding off a small amount onto the 2nd bobbin of the pair. When working further sections, this will then mean just winding off a little more from the fuller bobbins to make new pairs for each new section worked.
